



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

CALL FOR SUB RECIPIENTS TO IMPLEMENT THE GLOBAL FUND HIV GRANT IN SELECTED TWELVE (12) COUNTIES IN KENYA

This Call for Proposals is an open tender for eligible organizations interested in implementing the Global Fund HIV grant to apply as sub-recipients under the Kenya Red Cross Society, Global Fund Program to implement priority components in selected counties.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Kenya Red Cross Society (KRCS) is the largest humanitarian organization in Kenya with a vision is to be the most effective, most trusted and self-sustaining humanitarian organization in the country. KRCS was appointed by the Kenya Country Coordinating Mechanism (KCM) as the Civil Society Principal Recipient (PR) to manage resources under the Country's Global Fund HIV grant under the New Funding Model.

SCOPE OF WORK

The successful applicant will be required to contribute to achieving Vision 2030 through universal access to comprehensive HIV prevention, treatment and care for all in twelve (12) counties as follows:

The goal of the project is to contribute to achieving Vision 2030 through universal access to comprehensive HIV prevention, treatment and care for all. The objectives of the Program is to reduce new HIV infections by 75% and reduce AIDS related mortality by 25%.

The specific components to be implemented are:

1. Community Interventions to support Treatment, care and support
2. Prevention program with adolescents and young people aged 10-24 years
3. Demand creation for HIV prevention among general population especially men
4. Social mobilization to create demand for HIV testing services

KRCS Global Fund program seeks sub recipients that can implement in at least one of the twelve target counties.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants will have to be a legal entity registered in Kenya with the right to enter a contractual agreement with Kenya Red Cross Society. The applicant must have the mandate to work in the counties applied for. It must have no history of legal proceedings related to fraud or corruption. The applicant should be a Civil Society Organization (FBO, CBO, NGO, etc.) that fulfills the above criteria.

The applicant should have:

1. Active local presence for the last 3 years in the proposed county
2. The ability and willingness to work with County Government and local community to implement the grant activities
3. Approval and endorsement by the County Director of Health of the proposed county
4. Valid registration license from NGO board, Social services and other recognized regulatory licenses.
5. Valid Tax compliance or exemption certificate
6. Project management skills and experience to manage and deliver the grant.
7. Financial management capacity and strong internal controls.
8. The capability to manage and account properly for the total grant funds.
9. Experience in implementing HIV & AIDS prevention, treatment care and psychosocial support programs in the proposed county.
10. Experience working within the Community Health Strategy will be an added advantage.

Kindly note that special consideration will be provided for;

- *Organization with experience working with people with disabilities are particularly encouraged to apply.*
- *Private sector organization are encouraged to apply*

The technical and financial proposals should be separated and put in different envelopes clearly marked, enclosed and sealed in one plain envelope.
